**M**en's participation in the art and craft of quilting has varied widely across the centuries and in different parts of the world. While in America quilting is most often perceived as a pursuit of women, more men than ever are participating in quilt making. Social media has made it easier than ever for male quilters to find each other and connect across geographic boundaries. This exhibit at MQX attempts to capture a cross-section of the many styles that quilting men are exploring today.



### Exhibit Information:

One entry per man/group of men—entries may be any style, traditional, modern, wholecloth, or pictorial.

Entries may be embellished with specialty threads, beads, crystals, etc.

Minimum size is 200 perimeter inches.

\$10 entry fee per quilt.

Entry must be machine quilted—entrants may use any sewing machine... treadle, domestic, midarm, longarm, whatever. As long as it's machine quilted.

Deadline is February 1, 2020.

Quilts must be available for the month of April 2020. The show takes place from April 15–18.

Acceptance/Rejection and shipping information will arrive by February 20, 2020.
